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## Using a Golf Buggy in Hope Island Resort

One of the most preferred ways to traverse the spacious and beautifully landscaped grounds of Hope Island Resort (HIR) is via golf buggies.

Residents can travel by golf buggy from their homes to parks, swimming pools, Coles, Specialty Retail Shops, The Links Golf Club and Course, The Boardwalk Tavern, Restaurants, Fitness Centre and Tennis Courts etc the list goes on and on.

Whilst golf buggies are an extremely convenient and environmentally friendly way to travel all residents need to be aware of the following which applies to the use of golf buggies within HIR:-

- All golf buggies driven within HIR must be conditionally registered via QLD Transport. The conditional registration includes that golf buggies must have a maximum speed of 20kph.
- Persons driving golf buggies must have a current and valid driving licence.

Conditional registration is registration for non-standard vehicles that do not comply with the standard regulations for registration and have a genuine need for limited access to the road network. (<https://www.qld.gov.au/transport/registration/register/conditional/about-conditional>).



Whilst the Roadways and Waterways within HIR are private, QLD Police Services (QPS) are empowered to enforce traffic laws and regulations within HIR.

The roadways throughout HIR are shared by vehicles, golf buggies, pedestrians and cyclists and therefore it is very important to take care when traversing the roadways and to always be mindful of the shared usage.

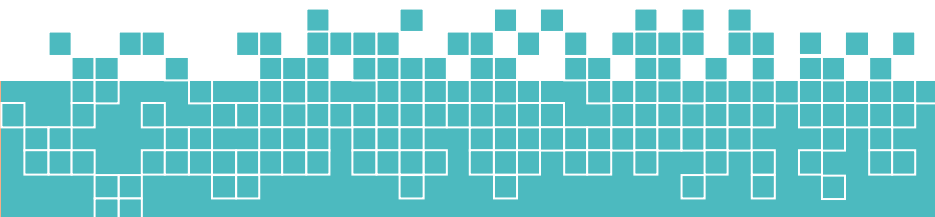

## HOPE ISLAND RESORT PRINCIPAL BODY CORPORATE Permit Conditions

The following conditions are applicable at all times:

1. All approved buggy's ('vehicles') must hold current vehicle registration with Department of Transport and Main Roads.
2. Operators of approved vehicles must keep vehicle registration current.
3. Operators of approved vehicles must hold a valid licence.
4. Approved vehicles must only cross Santa Barbara Road at the designated crossings
5. Approved vehicles must adhere to the designated yellow golf buggy line markings at all times and must not traverse any grassed areas.
6. Approved vehicles are not permitted to be stored or parked on the golf buggy path or anywhere within the designated pathway area unless for safety or traffic reasons.
7. The driving or manoeuvring of approved vehicles must not detrimentally affect or obstruct the movement of, or constitute a safety risk to other pedestrians, bike riders or other approved vehicles.
8. Operators of approved vehicles must comply with all signage erected on the Council Road Reserve and any directions from a Council authorised person or emergency services personnel.
9. This permit is granted subject to operators of approved vehicles accepting to indemnify the Principal Body Corporate & Gold Coast City Council in respect of any claims for personal injury and/or damage to property as a result of, or attributable to the use of golf buggies within the Council's owned/managed land.
10. Operators of approved vehicles indemnify and agree to keep indemnified the Principal Body Corporate and Gold Coast City Council against all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, losses, damages and expenses ("Claim") arising out of or in any way connected to, or resulting from the granting of this permit to the operator or which is connected to or resulting from operators of approved vehicles and/or Council land (all of which are referred to as "the indemnified acts or omissions") save to the extent that the Claim arises as a result of any negligent act or omission of the Principal Body Corporate or Gold Coast City Council.
11. Operators of approved vehicles release and discharge the Principal Body Corporate and Gold Coast City Council from any Claim relating to the indemnified acts or omissions which may be made against the Principal Body Corporate or Council save to the extent that the Claim arises as a result of any negligent act or omission of the Principal Body Corporate or Gold Coast City Council.
